Selection of the cheerleaders will be based on the following:

- A cheer, chant, and short dance that will be taught to you during the clinic.
- Rhythm and Precision
- Toe touch (Required for Varsity)
- Side herkie, and a front hurdler, left and right kick)
- Athleticism and physical fitness
- Scholastic achievement and eligibility
- Conduct
- Attitude, initiative, teamwork, leadership, work ethic, enthusiasm, and coachability.

Teams:

Like last year, we will have two teams at Heirway: Apprentice Squad and a Varsity Squad. The apprentice team will practice with the Varsity squad, and when ready, they will cheer on the line and dance at **home** games with the Varsity team. Until that time, they will cheer from the bleachers..making sure they know the words to each cheer, etc. Apprentice team will not travel to away games. Please note that Varsity cheerleaders also must be able to perform the dance cleanly before joining the team on the floor at half time.

What do you wear to tryouts?

During tryout please wear comfortable, length appropriate shorts and a t-shirt/tank top.

- Leggings can also be worn. NO SPAGETTI STRAPS
 - Shorts should be fingertip length.
 - Sports bras and proper undergarments must be worn.
 - No denim shorts or jewelry.
 - Your hair is to be pulled back into a high ponytail.
 - Tennis shoes must be worn. No non-athletic shoes are not acceptable.
 (Including Toms, Converse, Vans etc.)

What is required if I make the team?



Athletic Fee: Your \$150.00 athletic fee is due by September 1, 2017.

Please note on your check that it is for cheerleading. For those of you doing both Basketball and Cheerleading, please note that as well. It is an Heirway rule that you won't be able to practice until paid.

Banners: I am asking each cheerleader to sell at least one banner to help cover t-shirts and other uniform items. Otherwise they will be asked to purchase these items. I recommend you approach businesses you frequent and ask them to help. A detailed letter you can provide the company is attached, but here is the basic information: New banners are \$100.00, renewals are just \$100.00. Unfortunately, the athletic fee only covers travel costs. For more information, please ask me. We have a non-profit donation form, etc.

Volunteering: Everyone involved in a sport is asked to volunteer 3-4 times during the season. This can be done taking tickets, working concessions, etc. Kim Arnold will be sending around a schedule for you to sign up.

Items needed: Cheerleaders are required to provide white cheer shoes They are also required to provide low no show white socks.
